TITLE

A RESOLUTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING THE METHODOLOGY FOR THE SALE, VIA INTERNET AUCTION, OF MUNICIPALLY OWNED PROPERTY, INCLUDING VEHICLES, WHICH IS NO LONGER NEEDED FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE.

RESOLUTION NO. 4717/2024

WHEREAS, Ordinance #13326/2024, which passed on March 27, 2024, authorizes the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety to discard municipally owned property, including vehicles, which is no longer needed for any municipal purpose, via internet auction; and

WHEREAS, O.R.C. 721.15(D) specifies the process by which municipalities may discard municipal property, including vehicles, via internet auction; and

WHEREAS, the City shall adhere to the below methods with regard to the disposal, via internet auction, of municipal property, including vehicles, which is no longer needed for any municipal purpose; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That items for sale via Internet auction shall be listed for a minimum of ten (10) days, including Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays.

Section 2: That the City of Warren shall, and does, reserve the right to accept or reject any bid, in whole or in part; to waive any informalities or irregularities in any bid received; and to withdraw any invitation to bid at any time.

Section 3: That items shall be sold "as is," and without warranty, and post such fact on the auction site.

Section 4: That should a sale be made, it shall be made to the bidder with the highest bid.

Section 5: That this Council and the City of Warren shall assume no responsibility for, and shall have no responsibility for, costs incurred by any bidder prior to any sale.

Section 6: That this Council and the City of Warren, Ohio shall be registered with a third-party vendor: GovDeals, 6931 Arlington Road, Suite 200, Bethesda, MD 20814, 1-800-613-0156 to conduct any auction to be performed per this Resolution.

Section 7: That a copy of this Resolution shall be continuously posted to the City of Warren's website, www.warren.org (or its successor site) for 2024.

Section 8: That the Clerk of this Council is hereby authorized and directed, for and on behalf of this Council and the City of Warren, to twice publish, in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Warren, Ohio this Resolution and originating Ordinance #13326/2024 in their entirety. The second such publication shall be made not less than ten nor more than twenty days after the initial publication.

Section 9: That this resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by Law.
