Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program
and
Home Investment Partnership (HOME) Program

The CDBG and HOME programs are funded by the US Department of Housing and Urban Development under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 and its amendments and the National Affordable Housing Act of 1991.

All non-profit organizations serving the City of Warren, especially those serving people of low- and moderate-income, are invited to a public meeting to learn how to submit proposals for the use of CDBG and HOME program funding for 2010.

Non-Profit organizations that intend to propose projects are requested to attend **ONE** of the scheduled public meetings. **The administrator of the grant and the individual charged with writing the grant proposal are required to attend.** The meetings are designed to provide those wishing to make application, for CDBG and HOME funding, with an understanding of the programs' guidelines, regulations and requirements; and technical assistance in completing the application. The application process, funding process, and requirements once funded will be reviewed. **Applications will only be distributed to those attending the meetings.**

All meetings will be held in the Large Conference Room on the second floor of the Community Services Building at 418 Main Ave, SW, Warren.
