3146	12349/11	An ordinance consenting to the execution of an agreement between the Board of County Commissioners of Trumbull County and Main Light Electric Company, Inc. and Sferra Avenue Property, LLC., providing for tax incentives by a program of abatement of real property taxes over a period of ten (10) years.

3149		An ordinance providing for the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$8,800,000 to pay costs of acquiring, constructing, equipping, furnishing and otherwise improving a “One Stop” Municipal Services Building to house various city functions and operations, together with the acquisition of a site therefore and any other related interests in real property, site improvements and all necessary appurtenances thereto.

- 3153 An ordinance providing for the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$1,765,000 to pay costs of acquiring, constructing, reconstructing and otherwise improving the main building in the central operations complex, including an addition thereto, acquiring road construction and servicing vehicles, acquiring and installing mechanical lifts for the maintenance of vehicles and other equipment, and acquiring other equipment for use in maintaining, repairing and reconstructing city property, together with all necessary appurtenances thereto, for the City Public Service Department.
