

SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION

THE FOLLOWING LEGISLATION WAS PASSED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WARREN AND SIGNED BY THE MAYOR ON THE 11TH DAY OF JANUARY, 2012.

3214	4515/12	A resolution designating Enzo C. Cantalamessa, Director of Public Service and Safety as the authorized representative to sign all Water Department Loan Fund documents and to authorize application for a Water Department Loan Fund Loan for the City of Warren and authorizing him to perform any and all functions necessary or useful for said purposes.
3215	4516/12	A resolution designating Enzo C. Cantalamessa, Director of Public Service and Safety as the authorized representative to sign all Water Pollution Control Loan Fund documents and to authorize application for a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund Loan for the City of Warren and authorizing him to perform any and all functions necessary or useful for said purposes.

3216R	12381/12	An ordinance authorizing the Mayor and the Director to negotiate and to enter into contracts with Water Haulers for the sale by the City of Warren of raw bulk water and/or finished bulk water; repealing ordinance No. 12379/11.
3217	12382/12	An ordinance committing funds to the improvement of 0.24 miles of U.S. Route 422(Parkman Road, N.W.) by widening and replacement of the bridge over the Mahoning River, including pavement widening and sidewalk improvement with the City of Warren; requesting that the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation proceed with said improvement.
3167	12383/12	An ordinance to advertise for bids and to enter into a one year contract(s) with a one year renewable clause for the purchase of high calcium quicklime for use in the Water Pollution Control Center.
3168	12384/12	An ordinance to advertise for bids and to enter into a one year contract(s) with a one year renewable clause for the purchase of liquid emulsion polymer for use in the Water Pollution Control Center.
3169	12385/12	An ordinance to advertise for bids and enter into a one year contract(s) with a one year renewable clause for grit, screenings and catch basin debris removal at the Water Pollution Control Center.

3201		An ordinance for the purpose of repealing Section 131.12 (“Motor Vehicle impoundment and towing fee”) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Warren, effective February 1, 2012, and declaring an emergency.
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
