HOLIDAYS:

These are the holidays that we DO NOT WORK:

- NEW YEAR'S DAY
- MARTIN LUTHER KING DAY
- MEMORIAL DAY
- JULY 4TH
- LABOR DAY
- THANKSGIVING
- CHRISTMAS

During the week of these holidays, garbage pick up will be ***one day late***.

These are the holidays that we DO WORK:

- PRESIDENT'S DAY
- COLUMBUS DAY
- VETERAN'S DAY
- FRIDAY AFTER THANKSGIVING

During the week of these holidays, garbage pick up will be ***on schedule***.

- All City of Warren Sanitation customers will get a 96 gallon "Toter" for garbage and yard waste.
- If there is no "Toter" at your address, contact the Sanitation office at the above phone number.
- All garbage must be properly containerized in cans. Loose garbage may not be picked up.
- Extra cans from 50 to 110 gallons in size **and** of sufficient wall strength to be picked up by our fully automated truck arm may be set out also. Lid must be permanently attached or removed.
- Additional "Toters" will be delivered upon request for a one-time fee added to your utility bill.
- Each can must have **at least 3 feet clearance** around it to make room for the arm to wrap around.
- Each can must be facing with the lid opening toward the street - (see arrow on lid)
- Make sure can is not overloaded. Lid should be able to close.
- Bulky items such as furniture, carpet, mattresses, etc., will be picked up on garbage day by a separate truck. Make sure they are placed at least 3 feet from "toters".
- Garbage must be placed at curb by 4:00 a.m. but no more than 24 hrs before pick up and
- Cans must be removed to an appropriate rear or side location no more than 12 hrs after pick up.
- Violations, which persist, may result in a \$45.00 service fee.
- *Excessive piles* (over 2 cubic yards) will be assessed a **MINIMUM** of \$54.00 on the next utility bill.
- All fees are assessed to the current account holder at the time of service.
- If a pile is picked up at an address with no active acct, the owner of the property is liable to pay.
- During leaf season all properly bagged leaves will be taken free. Other times *Excessive pile* rule applies.
- During leaf season, leaves **must** be in **paper bio-degradable yard bags** or they will **not** be picked up.
- Service fees of \$45.00 may also be issued for special pick-ups when trash is out late or incorrectly.
- Limbs and brush must be cut in 4ft lengths or less and tied in bundles - 35 lbs. Max.
- No paint or hazardous material will be picked up. Please call the office for instructions.
- Appliances (and other metal) can be picked up for a \$15.00 fee (Call office) or drop off at Sanitation garage for free.
- Tires can be dropped off at the Sanitation garage-LIMIT: 4 TIRES. Driver's license will be required.
- Warren City **shall not** collect construction debris at the curb. Owner or occupant of premises shall be responsible for removal and disposal of such debris. Construction debris consists of "wood, paneling, dry wall, bricks, concrete, roofing shingles, floor tile, doors, windows, etc".
- We will take construction debris if placed in a roll-off box which was rented from us.
- Roll-off boxes (10 yards & 15 yards) are available for Warren Water customers and businesses.
