AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE CITY OF WARREN ACCEPTING FOR PUBLIC USE THE ROAD, ALL STORM SEWERS, ALL WATER LINES, ALL SANITARY SEWERS, ALL ASSOCIATED IMPROVEMENTS, AND ALL EASEMENTS FOR DRAINAGE AND UTILITIES, AS DEDICATED TO PUBLIC USE ON THE NORTHWEST INDUSTRIAL PARK REPLAT OF JRW PLAT NO. 1 RECORDED ON JANUARY 31, 2002 IN TRUMBULL COUNTY, OHIO RECORD OF PLATS IN VOLUME 51 AT PAGE 12, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 12794/18

WHEREAS, a road, storm sewers, water lines, sanitary sewers, associated improvements, and easements for drainage and utilities were dedicated to public use on the plat of the Northwest Industrial Park Replat of JRW Plat No. 1 recorded on January 31, 2002 in Trumbull County, Ohio Records of Plats in Volume 51 at Page 12: and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren, by and through its Council, now desires to accept same; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the road, all storm sewers, all water lines, all sanitary sewers, all associated improvements, and all easements for drainage and utilities, as dedicated to public use on the plat of the Northwest Industrial Park Replat of JRW Plat No. 1 recorded on January 31, 2002 in Trumbull County, Ohio Record of Plats in Volume 51 at Page 12, be, and the same hereby are, accepted by the City of Warren, Ohio for public use.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason that the road and the other dedicated improvements can be maintained by the City of Warren at the earliest possible time, without undue delay.
