| 3630 | 12682/16 | An ordinance for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety, for and on behalf of the City of Warren, to enter into an agreement with the Trumbull County Commissioners for the purpose of providing, during the year 2017, legal representation, through the office of the Public Defender, to qualifying indigent defendants charged in the Warren Municipal Court with violations of Warren City Ordinances where there is a possibility of incarceration and the legal right to representation has not been waived, and declaring an emergency. |
| 3631 | 12683/16 | An ordinance for the purpose of appropriating from the unappropriated, anticipated revenue of the general fund; transferring with the general fund; transferring within certain city funds; and appropriating from the unappropriated, unencumbered balance of certain city funds and declaring an emergency.   |
| 3632 | 12684/16 | An ordinance for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety to advertise for bids and to enter into a one year contract(s) (with a one year renewable clause) for the purchase of high calcium quicklime for use in the Water Pollution Control Center.   |
