



CGI Communications Statement Relating to Phone Contact Dating Tuesday August 18, 2015 in the City of Warren, OH

It has been brought to the attention of CGI Communications Inc. that a CGI phone number was being used in a robocalling scheme to dial members of the Warren, Ohio community. These automated calls asked receivers to spend 15 minutes answering a political survey and their views on the Warren Community.

These calls have absolutely no affiliation to CGI or our working partnership with Mayor Franklin and the City of Warren.

CGI discovered that our phone system was hacked by an outside party, using one of our in-bound only conference lines to make these dials. Our local telephone provider has been made aware of the situation and the necessary actions have been taken to eliminate the number from CGI record.

We have had a great relationship working with Mayor Franklin and members of the Warren Community in producing your community video program, currently featured on the Warren City web page. The issue has been resolved and hope to move past this unrelating incident in further building your community video project.
