All customers are issued one 96 gallon Toter. Please contact the department if one is not at your residence.

All garbage, before deposit in the container, shall be bagged and tied.

Containers, bags & bundles shall be placed curbside the evening before the designated collection day. Toter must be removed to an appropriate rear or side location no later than 12 hours after pick up.

Each Toter must have at least **3 feet clearance** around it .

Toter must be facing with the lid opening toward the street—see arrow on lid.

All refuse including plastic, paper or cloth bags shall be put into the container. No bags shall be permitted outside the container. To arrange delivery of additional Toters, please call the office. If the Toter becomes full, an additional Toter must be used. If it fits in the Toter, it should be in the Toter. This includes cardboard boxes . *Vegetative waste in biodegradable bags are permitted outside of the Toter.

All leaves to be collected and removed by the Environmental Services Department must be in biodegradable bags.

Items such as furniture, mattresses, box springs, etc. will be picked up on your scheduled pick-up day. Please make sure items are at least 3' from Toter.

Anything over 2 cubic yards will be assessed a minimum of \$54.00 on the utility bill. Fees will be assessed to the current account holder and/or property owner.

Limbs and brush must be cut in 4' lengths or less and tied in bundles—35# maximum.

City of Warren **will not** collect construction debris at the curb. Owner or occupant shall be responsible for removal and disposal. Construction debris consists of wood, paneling, dry wall, bricks, concrete, roofing materials, floor tile, windows, doors, etc.

Paint, hazardous material or car parts are not permitted in the toter, nor will be picked up curbside.

Roll-off boxes (6, 10, 15 & 20 yard) are available to rent and can be used for the disposal of construction and other non-hazardous debris.

Paint or hazardous material will not be picked up.

A “non-collection” notice will be issued when the above guidelines are not followed and your garbage may be left until the problem is corrected. A service fee of \$45.00 may be assessed when multiple non-collection notices are issued.

COLLECTION OF LEAVES FOR CITY OF WARREN RESIDENTS

Residents are **strongly** encouraged to mulch leaves and grass clippings to eliminate or greatly reduce the need for bags, but if necessary, leaves will be collected as follows:

Curbside collection will run from

Monday, October 31, 2016 through

Friday, December 2, 2016.

<u>AREA</u>	<u>PICK UP DAY</u>	
NW	MONDAY	please have bags out Sunday night
NE	TUESDAY	please have bags out Monday night
SE	WEDNESDAY	please have bags out Tuesday night
SW	FRIDAY	please have bags out Thursday night

- Leaves **must** be in biodegradable **paper** yard bags. Please **do not** put anything other than leaves or grass in the biodegradable bags. Absolutely no plastic will be picked up curb side.
- Bags should NOT be closed using tape or twist ties.
- Leaves in any other type of bag, box etc. will not be picked up.
- Biodegradable bags are available at many local stores; including hardware, grocery and drug.
- A roll-off will be located at the Water Pollution Control Department, 2323 Main Ave., S.W., for any resident that wishes to dispose of leaves (loose or in biodegradable paper bags). This will be available Monday thru Friday between the hours of 7:30 am and 2:30 pm Monday thru Friday. For further information, please contact John Gennock at 330-841-2757.
