**SUBJECT: TEMPORARY CLOSING OF EAST MARKET STREET
TEMPORARY CLOSING OF NILES ROAD (SR 169)**

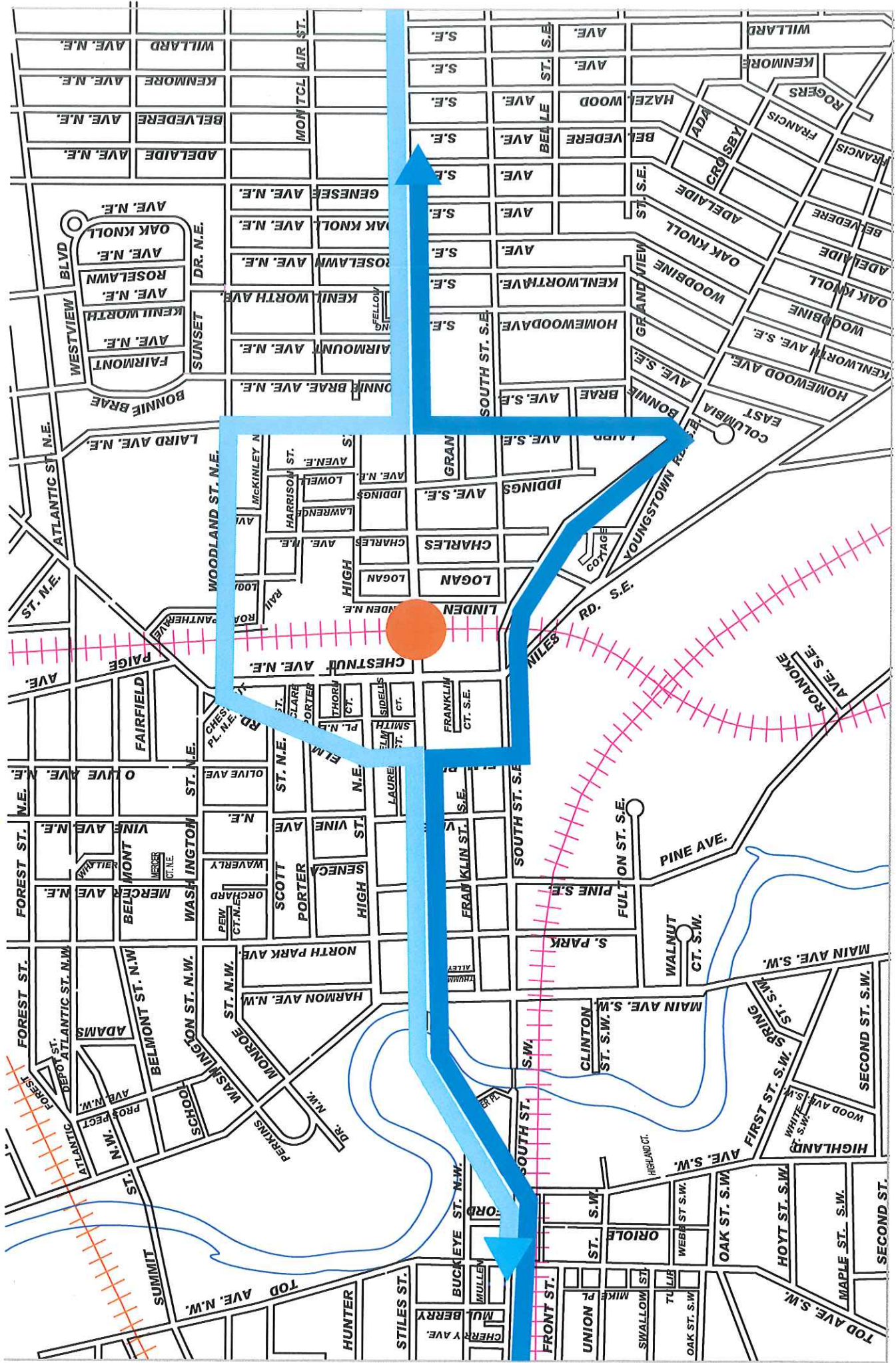
The Genesee and Wyoming railroad company has scheduled railroad crossing improvements for the sections of rail line that intersect East Market Street and Niles Road (SR 169) in the City of Warren. The scope of the project includes removing and replacing sections of rail and all surrounding pavement. The work will require a full road closure and detour for each of the crossings.

Beginning Monday, June 4th, East Market Street between Elm Road and Laird Avenue will be closed to through traffic. The closure is expected to be for five consecutive days. The posted detour for eastbound traffic will be south on Elm Road, then east on South Street and Warren Boulevard, then north on Laird Avenue to East Market Street. The posted detour for westbound traffic will be north on Laird Avenue, then west on Woodland Street, then south on Elm Road to East Market Street. Detour signs will be placed one week in advance of the road closure. Local access for businesses located within the work zone will be maintained.

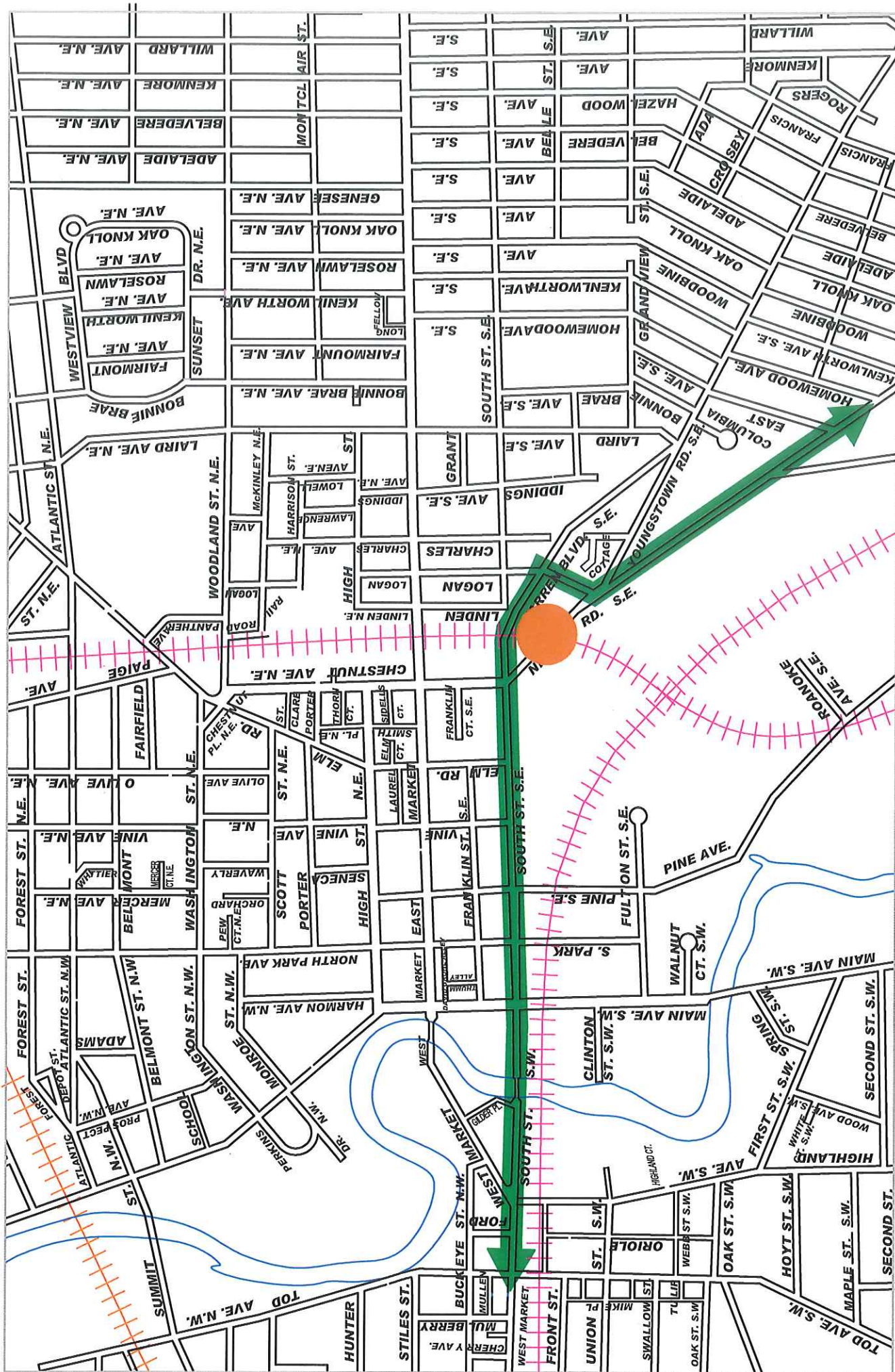
On Monday, June 11th, Niles Road (SR 169) between South Street and Logan Avenue will be closed to through traffic. The closure is expected to be for five consecutive days. Traffic may utilize South Street / Warren Boulevard and Logan Avenue as a detour. Signs will be placed one week in advance of the road closure. Local access for businesses located within the work zone will be maintained.
