3222	4517/12	A resolution for the purpose of designating Enzo C. Cantalamessa, Director of Public Service and Safety as the authorized representative to sign all Water Pollution Control Loan Fund documents for the downtown combined sewer separation project, and authorizing him to perform any and all functions necessary or useful for said purposes.

3220	12386/12	An ordinance for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and the Director to advertise for bids and to thereafter enter into contract(s) for energy efficiency upgrades at and to the City's Municipal Building.
3221	12387/12	An ordinance for the purpose of authorizing the Director of Public Service and Safety to enter into agreement(s) with the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation for the Riverwalk 2 project.
3223	12388/12	An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service and Safety to apply for a T.E.A. Grant for the construction of new community signs at various areas throughout the city.
3224	12389/12	An ordinance authorizing the Mayor and the Director to enter into contract(s) with a qualified consultant for the purposes of: comprehensively review and evaluating the insurance needs, wants and demands of the City of Warren; making recommendations relative to the insurance coverage, protection and programs; evaluating any relevant proposals or bids that the city may thereafter solicit.
3147AA	12390/12	An ordinance for the purpose of repealing and reenacting Chapter 752("Massage Establishments") of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Warren.
