TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO, TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO CONTRACT(S) FOR THE COSTS OF CONSTRUCTING, RECONSTRUCTING, RENOVATING, EQUIPPING, FURNISHING, AND OTHERWISE IMPROVING VARIOUS MUNICIPALLY OWNED BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES WITHIN THE CITY OF WARREN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13281/2023

WHEREAS, the City of Warren owns, operates, and maintains various buildings and structures for departmental use; and

WHEREAS, these buildings are in need of improvements; and

WHEREAS, this Council now desires to make these improvements, including but not limited to, roofing and parapet repairs, masonry and exterior façade or siding repairs, gutter and downspout repairs, concrete and masonry repairs, electrical and mechanical upgrades, exterior and interior door replacements or repairs, HVAC improvements, improvements for A.D.A. compliance, and concrete and paving repairs or resurfacing; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby are, authorized to advertise for bids and award contract(s) for repairs and improvements to various municipally-owned buildings and structures within the City of Warren, Ohio.

Section 2: That any said contract(s) to be entered into or participated in for improvements to the various municipally-owned buildings and structures shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of the proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety; and for the further reason to complete the improvements in a timely manner, during conducive weather, and without undue delay. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
