## TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO, TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO CONTRACT(S) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF PERMANENT RESTROOM FACILITIES AT THE WARREN COMMUNITY AMPHITHEATER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13/96/2023

WHEREAS, the City of Warren owns, operates, and maintains a Community Amphitheater venue for entertainment and other events for residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, while temporary, portable restrooms have been used in the past at the Warren Community Amphitheater, permanent restroom facilities are needed to establish more sanitary conditions for events when large gatherings take place; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

- Section 1: That the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby are, authorized to advertise for bids and award contract(s) for the construction of permanent restroom facilities at the Warren Community Amphitheater.
- Section 2: That any said contract(s) to be entered into or participated in for the construction of the permanent restroom facilities at the Warren Community Amphitheater shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of the proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.
- Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety; and for the further reason to complete the construction of the permanent restroom facilities in a timely manner, during conducive weather, and without undue delay. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
