TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WARREN, TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PACKARD MUSIC HALL SOUND SYSTEM UPGRADES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13317/2024

WHEREAS, the City of Warren, Ohio, has been entrusted with the maintenance upkeep of the W.D. Packard Music Hall; and

WHEREAS, the W.D. Packard Music Hall is in need of sound system upgrades; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That Warren City Council hereby approves the advertisement for bids for sound system upgrades at Packard Music Hall including equipment purchase(s) and professional installation.

Section 2: That the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby are, authorized, for and on behalf of the City of Warren, to enter into an agreement for:

City of Warren – Packard Music Hall Sound System Upgrades

Said project will consist of one contract for the purchase and professional installation of sound system equipment at Packard Music Hall. This will include the main PA System, stage support, intercom equipment, an integrated control system, and expert tuning.

Section 3: That the contract shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose, and for no other purpose.

Section 4: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were open to the public and in compliance with the law.

Section 5: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety. The further reason is so said funding and the proposed project relative thereto may be secured at the earliest possible time and without undue delay. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
