NEW LEGISLATION (RECEIVED JULY 16, 2020)

- Draft 0042 BROWN RUCKER** A resolution for the purpose of receiving funding from the County Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act to off set and/or defray costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of Section 5001 of the Cares Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(D) and any applicable regulations due to the public health emergency outbreak of the Coronavirus Disease (“Covid-19”) in the City of Warren, Ohio, and declaring an emergency.
- Draft 0043 BROWN** An ordinance for the purpose of authorizing the payment of specific orders or contracts upon receipt of certification of the Fiscal Officer of the sufficiency of funds for said expenditures, and declaring an emergency.
- Draft 0044 BROWN** An ordinance for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and Director of Public Service and Safety to enter into a service agreement(s) with Web-based Software Solution, IWORQ Systems, “IWORQ” Community Development and Public Works Software for the tracking of various code enforcement policies, permit and license management and payment processing for the Engineering, Planning and Building Department and the Warren City Health Department of the City of Warren, Ohio, and declaring an emergency.
- Draft 0045R* WHITE** A resolution for the purpose of recommending face coverings in any public space to limit the spread of Covid-19 in the City of Warren, Ohio, and declaring an emergency.

THIRD READING (REQUESTED BROWN)

- Draft 0039 BROWN RUCKER NOVAK** A resolution for the purpose of requesting and directing the Trumbull County Board of Elections to place before the electors, at and during the General Election to be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, the question of whether or not an ordinance for the renewal of the additional income tax to be levied on and after January 1, 2022, through December 31, 2026, at the rate of one-half of one percent (1/2%) per annum should be approved and passed, and declaring an emergency.
