### NEW LEGISLATION (RECEIVED JUNE 19, 2020)

- Draft 0036\* RUCKER BROWN** A resolution for the purpose of receiving funding from the coronavirus aid, relief, and economic security act, 116 Public Law 136, (The Cares Act) signed into law by the president of the United States on March 27, 2020 for reimbursement of any and all necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency outbreak of the Coronavirus Disease (“COVID-19”) IN THE City of Warren, Ohio, and declaring an emergency.
- Draft 0037 BROWN** An ordinance for the purpose of authorizing the payment of specific orders r contracts upon receipt of certification of the Fiscal Officer of the sufficiency of funds for said expenditures, and declaring an emergency.
- Draft 0038 BROWN** An ordinance for the purpose of appropriating from the unappropriated, unencumbered 2019 balances of certain city funds; appropriating from the unappropriated, unencumbered 2019 balances of the general fund; appropriating from the unappropriated; anticipated 2020 revenue of various city funds; appropriating from the unappropriated, anticipated 2020 revenue of the general fund and transferring within the general fund and declaring an emergency.
- Draft 0039 BROWN RUCKER NOVAK** A resolution for the purpose of requesting and directing the Trumbull County Board of Elections to place before the electors, at and during the General Election to be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, the question of whether or not an ordinance for the renewal of the additional income tax to be levied on and after January 1, 2022, through December 31, 2026, at the rate of one-half of one percent (1/2%) per annum should be approved and passed, and declaring an emergency.
- Draft 0040 RUCKER SAFFOLD** A resolution for the purpose of declaring racism as a public health crisis in the City of Warren, Ohio and to recommit our full attention to improving the quality of life and health of our minority residents by honestly and directly addressing the minority health inequities, including a systematic, data-driven focus on poverty, economic mobility and other factors that impact the social determinants of health in the City of Warren, and declaring an emergency.
