AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY TO ENTER INTO AN INTER-GOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH TRUMBULL COUNTY, OHIO, A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF OHIO, FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXERCISING, IN CONJUNCTION WITH SAID TRUMBULL COUNTY, THOSE RIGHTS THAT THE CITY OF WARREN HAS PURSUANT TO, AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH, SECTION 9.48 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 9.48 of the Ohio Revised Code permits municipal corporations in Ohio to participate with one or more other Ohio political subdivisions in contracts or joint purchasing programs for equipment, materials, supplies or services and some purchases may be in excess of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren desires to so participate with Trumbull County, Ohio, a political subdivision of the State of Ohio; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service of Safety be, and hereby are, authorized, for and on behalf of the City of Warren to enter into an Inter-Governmental Cooperation Agreement with Trumbull County, Ohio, a political subdivision of the State of Ohio, for the purpose of exercising, in conjunction with Trumbull County, Ohio, those rights that the City of Warren has pursuant to, and in accordance with, Section 9.48 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 2: That such Inter-Governmental Agreement as authorized by Section 1 of this Ordinance is exempt, per said Section 9.48 of the Ohio Revised Code, from advertising and bidding. Contracts entered into pursuant to an in accordance with said Inter-Governmental Agreement, however, may be subject to advertising and competitive bidding.

Section 3: That the City of Warren shall have complete discretion as to what, if any, contracts it may enter into or participate in pursuant to the aforementioned Inter-Governmental Agreement even in excess of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00).

Section 4: That the funds to pay for the contracts to be entered into or participated in pursuant to the aforementioned Inter-Governmental Agreement shall be paid from the appropriate accounts of the appropriate and affected departments.

Section 5: That any contract to be entered into or participated in pursuant to the aforementioned Inter-Governmental Agreement shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of the proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 6: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason that the integrity of the finances of the City of Warren may be more fully ensured at the earliest possible time and without undue delay. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
