## TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO A WRITTEN AGREEMENT WITH THE BOARD COMMISSIONERS OF TRUMBULL COUNTY, OHIO, FOR THE **PURPOSE** OF CONSOLIDATING THE **EMERGENCY** RESPONSE PROGRAM (HEREINAFTER 911), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The City of Warren, Ohio operates and maintains an Emergency Response Program (911); and

WHEREAS, Trumbull County provides similar services that overlap the City's program; and

WHEREAS, the consolidation of 911 services with Trumbull County would be more efficient and cost effective for both entities without any detrimental effect on the quality of services provided to the residents of the City of Warren; and

WHEREAS, the Trumbull County Commissioners are agreeable to a consolidation of programs with the City of Warren, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to support the consolidation of the 911 Emergency Response Program with the Trumbull County Commissioners without any further delay; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service of Safety be, and hereby are, authorized, for and on behalf of the City of Warren to expedite and enter into a written agreement with the Board of County Commissioners of Trumbull County, Ohio, for and on behalf of Trumbull County, Ohio, for the purpose of consolidating the 911 Services for the City of Warren, Ohio.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason that the residents of the City of Warren and Trumbull County may be more fully safeguarded at the earliest possible time and without undue delay. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
