AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, TO ADVERTISE AND ENTER INTO CONTRACT(S) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION FOR A 1,200 FOOT, 16-INCH WATERLINE TO THE CLEAN ENERGY FUTURE-LORDSTOWN, LLC FACILITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 12657/16

WHEREAS, this Council and the City of Warren, by and through Ordinance No. 12637/16 (passed and adopted by this Council, and signed by the Mayor of the City of Warren, on February 24, 2016), authorized professional services related to the design and construction administration services for a 1,200 foot, 16-inch water line to the Clean Energy Future-Lordstown, LLC Facility; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires that said construction proceed accordingly; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service and Safety be, and are hereby, authorized, for and on behalf of the City of Warren, to advertise for bids for the construction of a 1,200 foot, 16-inch water line to the Clean Energy Future-Lordstown, LLC facility, in accordance with plans and specifications on file with the Office of the Director of Public Service and Safety, and, after advertising for bids according to law, to enter into whatever contract(s) which may be useful or necessary to accomplish said purpose.

Section 2: That any such agreement(s) as provided for in Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be in substantial compliance and conformity with all laws of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: That the contract(s) shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason that the continued efficient and effective operation of the City of Warren may be more fully insured at the earliest possible time and without undue delay and for the further reason that the construction may proceed during conductive weather. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
