WHEREAS, there exists a need to: appropriate from the unappropriated,
unencumbered balances of various City funds; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure, in part, in that the
same provides for the usual daily operation of the City of Warren; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated,
unencumbered 2015 balances of various City funds, the sums as follows:

Section 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety,
and for the further reason that the appropriations are necessary for the continued daily
operation of the affected departments. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into
immediate effect.
