AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND ENTER INTO A WATER POLLUTION CONTROL LOAN FUND AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO A COMPREHENSIVE FLOW STUDY OF SEWER SYSTEMS IN THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO AND DESIGNATING A DEDICATED REPAYMENT SOURCE FOR THE LOAN IS: THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FUND 703 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 2664/16

WHEREAS, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency has directed the City of Warren, Ohio to conduct a comprehensive flow study of sewer systems in the City of Warren; Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren, intends to apply for a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) to conduct a comprehensive flow study of sewer systems in the City of Warren, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Water Pollution Control Loan Fund requires the Government authority to pass legislation for application of a loan and the execution of an Agreement as well as designating a dedicated repayment source; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service of Safety be, and hereby are, authorized, for and on behalf of the City of Warren to apply for a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund loan, sign all documents for and enter into a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund Application with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio Water Development Authority for the purpose of a comprehensive flow study of sewer systems in the City of Warren, Ohio, on behalf of the City of Warren, Ohio.

Section 2: That any contract to be entered into or participated in pursuant to the aforementioned study shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of the proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 3: That the dedicated source of repayment will be Water Pollution Control Fund 703.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason to alleviate future basement flooding in the downtown area of the City of Warren and may be more fully ensured at the earliest possible time and without undue delay. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
