WHEREAS, at the Election to be held on Tuesday, November 8th, 2016, the voters in the Warren City School District will have an opportunity to vote for the Warren City Schools Renewal levy; and

WHEREAS, the passage of the renewal levy will help to maintain a comprehensive Education Program for the students attending Warren City Schools; and

WHEREAS, the cornerstone and foundation of any community is a strong educational system; and

WHEREAS, the Warren City School District has improved the quality of the education it provides to the children of this community; and

WHEREAS, the Warren City School District has further demonstrated its ability to cut costs and improve student learning simultaneously; and

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:
