TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CONTRACT(S) FOR MULTI-YEAR ASSET MANAGEMENT FOR THE ENGINEERING, REPAIR, SUSTAINABILITY, WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF WATER STORAGE TANKS AND APPURTENANT FACILITIES OWNED, OPERATED AND MAINTAINED BY THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO WATER DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 12694/16

WHEREAS, it is necessary to maintain, repair and manage Water Storage Tanks and Appurtenant Facilities owned, operated and maintained by the City of Warren, Ohio Water Department for proper operation; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code, Section 9.29, allows the City to enter into, by direct negotiation, multi-year water quality management and maintenance contracts; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service of Safety be, and hereby are, authorized, for and on behalf of the City of Warren to negotiate and enter into Professional Service Contract(s) for a Multi-year Asset Management used for the Engineering, Repair, Sustainability, Water Quality Management and Maintenance of Water Storage Tanks and appurtenant facilities owned, operated and maintained by the City of Warren, Ohio Water Department.

Section 2: That any contract to be entered into or participated in pursuant to the aforementioned study shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of the proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason that the effective operation of the City of Warren Water Department may be fully ensured at the earliest possible time and without undue delay. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
