TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT(S) FOR TECHNICAL SERVICES RELATING TO PRETREATMENT COORDINATION SUBSEQUENT TO THE ISSUANCE OF THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO'S NEW OHIO EPA NPDES PERMIT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 12722

WHEREAS, the City of Warren, Ohio Water Pollution Control Department implements an Ohio EPA approved industrial pretreatment program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren anticipates receiving a renewal of our current Ohio EPA NPDES Permit (3PE00008*OD); and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren will be required to confirm pollutants requiring local limits and calculate the maximum allowable headworks loading (MAHL) for each pollutant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren will be required to calculate the domestic background load of each pollutant and the pollutant loadings available for industrial users; and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren will be required to complete a draft technical justification report for submission to the Ohio EPA; and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren will be required upon approval of the technical justification report, develop new administrative orders for each industrial user; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service and Safety be, and are hereby, authorized, for and on behalf of the City of Warren, to enter into a contract(s) according to law for the purpose of technical services relating to pretreatment coordination subsequent to the issuance of the City of Warren, Ohio's new Ohio EPA NPDES Permit.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety of the City of Warren. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
