A RESOLUTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO TO SUBMIT AN OHIO WATER POLLUTION CONTROL LOAN FUND – WATER RESOURCE RESTORATION SPONSOR PROGRAM (WRRSP) – YEAR 2021 PROJECT NOMINATION FORM FOR THE MAHONING RIVER SUMMIT STREET DAM REMOVAL PROJECT AND THAT THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO WOULD SUBMIT THE PROJECT NOMINATION FORM AS A WRRSP "IMPLEMENTER" TO OBTAIN A GRANT FROM THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR THE COMPLETION OF SAID PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio through the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) offers financial assistance for projects that specifically target the protection and restoration of high-quality streams and wetlands through the Water Resource Restoration Sponsor Program (WRRSP); and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren, Ohio desires financial assistance through the Water Resource Restoration Sponsor Program (WRRSP) for the removal of the Mahoning River Summit Street Dam located in the City of Warren, Ohio; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That this Council and the Administration of the City of Warren, Ohio approves filing an application for financial assistance through the Water Resource Restoration Sponsor Program (WRRSP) for the removal of the Mahoning River Summit Street Dam.

Section 2: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby are, authorized and directed to execute and file a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) – Water Resource Restoration Sponsor Program (WRRSP) – Year 2021 Project Nomination Form for the Mahoning River Summit Street Dam Removal Project and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance for said project.

Section 3: That the Auditor of the City of Warren, Ohio agrees to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and to become eligible for reimbursement under the terms and conditions of the Water Resource Restoration Sponsor Program (WRRSP).

Section 4: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason that the City of Warren, Ohio may comply with funding and programing deadlines established by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA). WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall go into immediate effect.
