AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR
OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY TO
ENTER INTO CONTRACT(S) WITH A FIRM TO
PROVIDE TECHNICAL SERVICES RELATIVE
TO THE CONVERSION OF THE CITY'S
FINANCIAL RECORDS TO CONFORM WITH
GENERALLY ACCEPTED ACCOUNTING
PRINCIPLES AS RECOMMENDED BY THE
STATE AUDITOR'S OFFICE AND REQUIRED
BY THE OHIO REVISED CODE, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 12953/2020

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City of Warren to obtain specialized technical services relative to the conversion of the City's financial records to conform with generally accepted accounting principles; and

WHEREAS, this conversion is recommended by the Auditor of State's Office and required by the Ohio Revised Code; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service of Safety be, and hereby are, authorized to enter into contract(s) with a firm to provide technical services relative to the conversion of the City's financial records to conform with generally accepted accounting principles.

Section 2: That the contract(s) to be entered into is for professional services, which obviated the necessity of more formal bidding procedures.

Section 3: That the funds to pay for said contract(s) to be entered into shall be paid from Account Number 100-250-530-000 contracted services.

Section 4: That the contract(s) shall first be approved by the Law Director and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of proper vouchers signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 5: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason that the integrity of the fiscal environment of the City of Warren may be more fully insured at the earliest possible time and without undue delay. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
