WHEREAS, the Packard Park Pedestrian Bridge has been permanently closed for safety issues due to a substantial degree of corrosion damage; and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren desires financial assistance through the Federal Land and Water Conservation Fund Program; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Council of the City of Warren, supports and approves filing an application for financial assistance through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) for a Federal Land and Water Conservation Grant for the Packard Park Pedestrian Bridge Replacement Project.

Section 2: That the Council of the City of Warren, supports, approves, authorizes and directs the Director of Public Service and Safety to execute and file an application with the through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance for said projections.

Section 3: That the Council of the City of Warren, supports the Auditor of the City of Warren to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and to become eligible for reimbursement under the terms and conditions of the Federal Land and Water Conservation Fund Program.

Section 4: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety and for the further reason that the City of Warren may timely comply with funding and programming deadlines established by the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) and the Federal Land and Water Conservation Fund Program.
