TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF APPROVING, ORDAINING AND IMPLEMENTING THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO AND THE OHIO PATROLMAN'S BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION FOR RANK OFFICERS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 12970/2020

WHEREAS, negotiations with the Ohio Patrolman's Benevolent Association For Rank Officers have recently been completed; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to approve, ordain and implement as law the collective bargaining agreement entered into as a result of said negotiations; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the collective bargaining agreement finalized on October 9, 2020, as a result of negotiations between the City of Warren, Ohio and the Ohio Patrolman's Benevolent Association For Rank Officers, be, and the same hereby is, approved and ordained as law as to those employees expressly covered by said agreement, all to be effective on and after the effective date of said agreement as expressly stated within said agreement. A copy of said collective bargaining agreement is attached hereto as "EXHIBIT A". Said "EXHIBIT A" is hereby incorporated within this Ordinance as if fully rewritten herein.

Section 2: That the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to pay those employees covered by this Ordinance. Said employees shall be paid only the compensation and pay set forth in the appropriate sections of the aforementioned agreement.

Section 3: That the Director of Public Service and Safety shall have the responsibility of administering the pay plan and the provisions of the aforementioned agreement.

Section 4: That, effective January 1, 2020, Ordinance No. 12679/16, as amended, if amended, be, and the same hereby is, repealed in its entirety.

Section 5: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason that the wages and terms and conditions of employment of the employees covered by the aforementioned agreement should be brought up to date without any undue delay. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
