TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WARREN TO ENTER INTO A FIVE (5) YEAR LEASE TO PURCHASE AGREEMENT(S) FOR A COMBINATION SEWER CLEANER PER THE STATE OF OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES STATE TERM SCHEDULE NUMBER OHIO STS:800835 INDEX:STS670, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13004/2021

WHEREAS, the existing 2015 Vactor Manufacturing Model 2110 PLUS Services Combination Sewer Cleaner of the Water Pollution Control Center in the City of Warren, Ohio is reaching the end of its reliable service life; and

WHEREAS, in order to maintain the efficient operation of said department, the existing High Pressure Sewer Cleaner needs to be replaced; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety, on behalf of the City of Warren, be, and hereby are, authorized to enter into a Five (5) year lease to purchase agreement with the State of Ohio approved vendor for a Combination Sewer Cleaner per the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services State Term Schedule Number 800835.

Section 2: That the equipment to be leased to purchase is part of the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services State Term Schedule Number 800835, which obviates the need for formal bidding procedures.

Section 3: That the funds for payment of said Lease to Purchase Agreement shall be paid from Account No(s). 720-470-530-000 and 703-450-530-000.

Section 4: That the lease to purchase agreement shall first be approved by the Law Director and the City Auditor, be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 5: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety of the City of Warren and for the further reason that it is necessary to supplement the present Combination Sewer Cleaner which has become less than optimal in its usefulness in order to continue efficient service by the Water Pollution Control Center at the earliest possible time and without undue delay. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
