TITLE

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT(S) WITH THE OHIO EPA AND EASTGATE AND ANY OTHER AGREEMENT(S) AND / OR CONTRACT(S) WHICH MAY BE NECESSARY OR USEFUL FOR THE ENGINEERING, PLANNING, AND DESIGN / BUILD SERVICES NEEDED FOR THE REMOVAL OF THE SUMMIT STREET DAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13013/2021

WHEREAS, the City of Warren received grant funding from the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) and the Eastgate Regional Council of Governments for the Summit Street Dam Removal Project (Project); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code and Ohio Administrative Code, the City of Warren shall commence to perform the Project. NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the the Mayor and Director of Public Service and Safety be, and are hereby, authorized to obtain and evaluate Statements of Qualifications and enter into an agreement with a Criteria Engineer, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA), Eastgate, a Design / Build Contractor, the Water Resource Restoration Program, and Design Build Consulting Engineers and any other agreements which may be necessary or useful for the subject project as required by Section 153.692 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason that the City of Warren, Ohio may comply with funding and programming deadlines established by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA). WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
