AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO, TO SOLICIT REQUESTS FOR QUALIFICATIONS AND BIDS TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT(S) FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING AND CONTRACTUAL SERVICES TO THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO FOR THE REMOVAL OF ACCUMULATED SEDIMENT IN SANITARY SEWERS THROUGHOUT WARREN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13055/2021

WHEREAS, The City of Warren Sanitary Sewer System, consisting of 195 miles of pipes ranging in size from 6 inches to 48 inches, has line segments throughout the City with accumulated sediment resulting in decreased system hydraulic capacity; and

WHEREAS, these referenced engineering services are required to precisely locate and quantify the accumulated sediment to more accurately bid the services of a qualified contractor to remove that sediment from the sanitary sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the removal of that accumulated sediment will improve the hydraulic capacity of the Warren Sanitary Sewer System; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby are, authorized, for and on behalf of the City of Warren, Ohio to solicit requests for qualifications from an engineering firm and bids from qualified contractors to quantify the sewer sediment needing to be removed, to remove said sediment and to enter into a contract(s) according to Law for conducting the aforementioned sewer cleaning.

Section 2: That any contract(s) to be entered into or participated in for these purposes on behalf of the Water Pollution Control Department shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of the proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
