AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WARREN, TO SOLICIT REQUESTS FOR QUALIFICATIONS AND ENTER INTO CONTRACT(S) FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING PROFESSIONAL SERVICES TO THE CITY OF WARREN FOR STORM WATER CONSULTATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13085/2021

WHEREAS, the City of Warren owns, operates and maintains 138 miles of separate storm sewers and, as such, is required by the EPA to meet regulatory requirements for the Warren Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4); and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren is required to update the related Codified Ordinances to conform to State and Federal Storm Water requirements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren is required to update the Water Pollution Control Facility's Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWP3) in accordance with the City of Warren's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit; and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren must provide review of commercial project plans and construction for conformation with existing storm water regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren would benefit from Storm Water Master Planning to improve storm water drainage from City of Warren streets; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service and Safety be, and are hereby authorized, for and on behalf of the City of Warren, to solicit requests for qualifications from consulting firm(s) and enter into a contract(s) according to law for the City of Warren to meet MS4 regulatory requirements, update the Storm Water Codified Ordinances, update the WPC SWP3, and oversee Storm Water Master Planning.

Section 2: That any contract to be entered into or participated in to provide these Storm Water Consultation services shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of the proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purposes and for no other purpose.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason to maintain and improve the integrity of the City of Warren's Storm Water System. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
