AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A TWO YEAR CONTRACT(S) FOR THE HAULING OF GRIT AND SCREENINGS IN THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL CENTER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13088/2022

WHEREAS, grit, bar rack screenings, and catch basin debris are collected at the Water Pollution Control Center in the course of normal operations of the treatment facility and collection system;

WHEREAS, expenses for hauling and disposal of this material are projected to exceed the \$50,000.00 per year limit set in the Ohio Revised Code; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby are, authorized to advertise for bids for the hauling of grit and screenings in the Water Pollution Control Center, in accordance with plans and specifications therefore on file in the office of the Director of Public Service and Safety, and, after advertising for bids according to law, to enter into whatever contract(s) which may be useful or necessary to accomplish the said purpose.

Section 2: That said contract(s) shall be for two years.

Section 3: That said contract(s) shall be paid from Account No. No. 703-450 530-000.

Section 4: That the contract(s) shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to disburse said funds upon receipt of proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 5: That this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
