TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO ONE YEAR CONTRACTS WITH ADDITIONAL ONE YEAR RENEWABLE CLAUSES FOR THE PURCHASE OF BOTH SODIUM HYPOCHLORITE AND SODIUM BISULFITE FOR USE IN THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL CENTER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13117/2022

WHEREAS, sodium hypochlorite and sodium bisulfite are used at the Water Pollution Control Center for disinfection of the treated wastewater prior to it being discharged to the Mahoning River, and;

WHEREAS, previous annual purchase quantities were not sufficient to require contracting, but, with recent chemical price escalation may now be necessary; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby are, authorized to advertise for bids for the purchase of both sodium hypochlorite and sodium bisulfite for use in the Water Pollution Control Center, in accordance with plans and specifications therefor on file in the office of the Director of Public Service and Safety, and, after advertising for bids according to law, to enter into whatever contracts which may be useful or necessary to accomplish said purpose.

Section 2: That said contract(s) shall each be for one year, with a one-year renewable clause.

Section 3: That said contract(s) shall be paid from Account No. 703-450 541-000.

Section 4: That the contract(s) shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to disburse said funds upon receipt of proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 5: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety, and for the further reason that an early delivery date is necessary in order to maintain chemical supplies at a safe level for proper operation of the department.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
