TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY TO RECEIVE QUOTES AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT(S) FOR THE PURCHASE OF A MOBILE NEIGHBORHOOD HEALTH CLINIC FOR USE BY THE WARREN CITY HEALTH DISTRICT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13180/2022

WHEREAS, Trumbull Memorial Health Foundation has awarded a grant of \$184,149 to the Warren City Health District; and

WHEREAS, said grant monies may be properly used to assist the City of Warren with the purchase of a mobile neighborhood health clinic; and

WHEREAS, on May 25, 2022, this Council passed Ordinance #13130/2022, which designated ARP funds for approved uses to each Council member specifically and equitably at large; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires that such a purchase of a mobile neighborhood health clinic take place; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the entirety of the Trumbull Memorial Health Foundation be used for the purchase of a mobile neighborhood health clinic.

Section 2: That, should additional funds be required for the purchase of the mobile neighborhood health clinic, Councilman White has pledged up to \$75,000 of his allocated portion of ARP funds towards the purchase of a mobile neighborhood health clinic.

Section 3: That the total purchase price for the purchase of such a mobile neighborhood health clinic shall not exceed two hundred and fifty-nine thousand, one hundred forty-nine dollars (\$259,149.00), purchased exclusively through the use of grant money and ARP funds.

Section 4: That the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby are, authorized to receive quotes for the purchase of the mobile neighborhood health clinic for use by the City of Warren's Health District, in accordance with the specifications of said grant on file in the office of the Deputy Health Commissioner of the Health District; and, after receiving quotes, to enter into any such agreement(s) that may be useful or necessary for said purchase.

Section 5: That the agreement(s) shall first be approved by the Law Director and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and no other purpose.

Section 6: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety, and for the further reason that the assistance of the City Health District will be more accessible to all residents, this Ordinance enacted at the earliest possible time and without undue delay. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
