TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO, TO ADVERTISE A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT(S) FOR A STREETLIGHT AUDIT AND PURCHASE SUPPORT FOR LIGHT EMITTING DIODE (LED) LIGHT BULBS FOR STREET LIGHTS WITHIN THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13270/2023

WHEREAS, this Council supports and approves of measures that would conserve energy and lower costs on the City's electrical bills; and

WHEREAS, on April 27, 2022, this Council passed Ordinance Number 13123/2022, which authorized the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety to use a portion of the Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council (NOPEC) Energized Community Grant for a streetlight fixture conversion feasibility study; and

WHEREAS, now that the feasibility study is completed, a request for proposals for a streetlight audit and purchase support can and should be advertised in order to receive the benefit of competitive pricing; NOW THEREFORE



BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby are, authorized to advertise a request for proposals for a streetlight audit and purchase support for LED lightbulbs for said streetlights for use in the City of Warren, Ohio, in accordance with plans and specifications therefore on file in the office of the Director of Public Service and Safety, and, after advertising for proposals according to law, to enter into whatever contract(s) which may be useful or necessary to accomplish the said purpose.

Section 2: That the contract(s) shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to disburse said funds upon receipt of proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
