TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT(S) WITH TYLER TECHNOLOGIES FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE VARIOUS SOFTWARE AND HARDWARE FOR THE CITY'S COMPUTER SYSTEMS TO CONCLUDE DECEMBER 31, 2026, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13308/2024

WHEREAS, there exists a need to provide for the maintenance of the various software and hardware for the City's computer systems; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby are, authorized to enter into contract(s) with Tyler Technologies for the maintenance of the various software and hardware for the City's computer systems to conclude December 31, 2026.

Section 2: That the Auditor shall make funds available to pay for said contract(s).

Section 3: That the contract(s) shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose, and for no other purpose.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety. The further reason is so the continued efficient and effective operation of the City of Warren's computer systems may be more fully ensured at the earliest possible time and without undue delay. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
