TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO, TO ENTER INTO A WRITTEN EASEMENT AGREEMENT WITH TRUMBULL COUNTY TO PROVIDE ACCESS FOR THE TRU-WESTERN RESERVE GREENWAY BIKE TRAIL – PHASE 4, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13330/2024

WHEREAS, the City of Warren, Ohio, owns property adjacent to the Western Reserve Greenway Bike Trail; and

WHEREAS, the County has deemed it desirable and necessary to appropriate a portion of the City's property; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide access by way of a recorded easement; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to support the completion of the TRU-Western Reserve Greenway Bike Trail without further delay; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service and Safety, for and on behalf of the City of Warren, be, and hereby are, authorized to execute and deliver to Trumbull County, Ohio, an easement regarding City-owned property, which is more fully described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

Section 2: That the easement shall be in a form substantially the same as Exhibit "B" attached hereto.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety. The further reason for this emergency measure is so the completion of the TRU-Western Reserve Greenway Bike Trail – Phase 4 may proceed at the earliest possible time and without undue delay. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
