What is HEAP?


The Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) is a federally funded program administered by the Ohio Development Services Agency.

It helps eligible Ohioans pay their home energy bill. The benefit is applied directly to a customer's utility bill or bulk fuel bill. The amount of the benefit is determined by the number of people in the household, the heating source, and the region of residence.

How Do I Apply?

Call the Area Agency on Aging 11 and request an application be sent to you.

We will send the application to you for FREE or direct you to one of our many community partners who will assist you with the application process.

The income guidelines are as follows:

2	up to \$28,035
3	up to \$35,280
4	up to \$42,525
5	up to \$49,770
6	up to \$57,015
7	up to \$64,277
8	up to \$71,557
