Trumbull Community Action Program (TCAP) can assist eligible Trumbull County households that – because of COVID-19 – are behind on rent; facing eviction; behind on house payments; facing foreclosure; and behind on water and/or sewer bills. For households that qualify, TCAP will make payments directly to the landlord, bank, business, or water company.

Criteria for eligibility: (1) must be a Trumbull County resident; (2) household hardship is due to the COVID-19 pandemic; (3) total household income must be at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.

To make application, call to schedule an appointment for a telephone interview through TCAP's appointment line at 330-951-0015. Listen carefully and follow the prompts.

Some of the information needed will include (a.) Names, dates of birth, and Social Security Cards for all household members; (b.) Proof of income for all household members for a minimum of the past 30 days; (c.) Eviction or past due notice and lease agreement; (d.) Notice of late house payment; (e.) Past due water bill or disconnection notice; (f.) Copy of Photo ID; (g.) Explanation and/or proof of hardship as caused by COVID-19.

Funding for these services is slated to end on December 30, 2020.
